Notes on Vegetable Varieties and Tips for Growing a Great Garden

- On our website, there are notes about specific varieties and tips on how to grow different crops. These are from our own experiences gardening and farming, and also what we have learned from other gardeners (like you!), farmers, books and workshops. Look for the Dave and Linda's thoughts section on the website!
- We have several varieties of zucchini, pumpkins and winter squash with resistance to **powdery mildew**. Look for the letters PMR in the variety description.
- We have two varieties of tomatoes with resistance to **early blight and late blight** (Jasper Red Cherry and Defiant PhR), and two varieties with tolerance to blight (Juliet and Honey Bunch Red Grape). Early blight (despite its name) tends to become noticeable right around harvest time. It reduces the harvest of quality fruit. Late blight is the blight that caused the great Irish potato famine. It can strike at any time in the season and causes total crop loss. One of the best strategies is to plant resistant varieties. Please see our website for other suggestions on how to prevent diseases in your tomatoes. Jasper and Defiant are only offered in 4" pots because the seeds are so expensive.

What happened to my favorite variety? It is not on the list this year.

Sometimes the seed companies have seed failures. Sometimes sales are slow and we decide to add something new and different in its place. Let us know if you want us to bring something back! We do our best to add your crop suggestions to our list each year.
